- → Declaration of Delta County a State of Emergency Area
- → Continued support and funding for statewide trail systems

## **LONG TERM ISSUES AFFECTING THE REGION:**

- → Need for long term energy solutions in the Upper Peninsula
- → Workforce preparation to fill gaps
- → Increase funding and support for P-20
- → Need for infrastructure upgrades and sustainable funding ie. roads, transmission, broadband, cellular coverage
- → Cease of operations of Empire Mine in 2017
- → Revenue Sharing
